Under this agreement, the contractor will provide a complete, fully integrated solution in real time, content creation and delivery medium for Monroe County Sheriff's Office staff involved in the training of police recruits/probationary deputies.

A request for proposals was issued for this contract and International Business Information Technologies, Inc. d/b/a LEFTA Systems was selected as the most qualified to provide this service.

The specific legislative action required is to authorize the County Executive, or her designee, to execute a contract, and any amendments thereto, with International Business Information Technologies, Inc. d/b/a LEFTA Systems, 10950-60 San Jose Blvd., Suite 101, Jacksonville, Florida 32223, for a Field Training Officer Software Program, in an amount not to exceed \$38,000, for the period of January, 1 2018 through December 31, 2018.
