RESOLUTION NO. ____ OF 2018

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT WITH PARADIGM ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES, INC. FOR PROFESSIONAL ENVIRONMENTAL TESTING TERM SERVICES

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE COUNTY OF MONROE, as follows:

Section 1. The County Executive, or her designee, is hereby authorized to execute a contract, and any amendments thereto, with Paradigm Environmental Services, Inc., for environmental testing term services, in a total annual amount not to exceed \$150,000, for the period of January 1, 2018 through December 31, 2018, with the option to renew for two (2) additional one-year extensions, with escalations for the extensions to be limited to an amount equal to the increase in the previous year's Consumer Price Index (U.S. City Average CPI-U from the Bureau of Labor Statistics).

Section 2. Funding for these services, consistent with authorized uses, is included in various capital fund(s).

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect in accordance with Section C2-7 of the Monroe County Charter.

Subject: Authorize a Contract with Paradigm Environmental Services, Inc. for Professional Environmental Testing Term Services

Honorable Legislators:

I recommend that Your Honorable Body authorize a contract with Paradigm Environmental Services, Inc., in a total annual amount not to exceed \$150,000, for environmental testing term services, for the period of January 1, 2018 through December 31, 2018, with the option to renew for two (2) additional one-year extensions, with escalations for the extensions to be limited to an amount equal to the increase in the previous year's Consumer Price Index (U.S. City Average CPI-U from the Bureau of Labor Statistics).

This contract will provide Monroe County with environmental sampling and laboratory testing services when asbestos or other potentially hazardous materials are encountered and must be dealt with in accordance with applicable codes and regulations. This contract establishes an agreed upon rate for a variety of environmental sampling and laboratory testing services so that when services are required, the County is assured of a timely response to projects.

Several consultants were considered, with Paradigm Environmental Services, Inc. rated the most qualified to provide these services.

The specific legislative action required is to authorize the County Executive, or her designee, to execute a contract, and amendments thereto, with Paradigm Environmental Services, Inc., 179 Lake Avenue, Rochester New York 14608, for environmental testing term services, in a total annual amount not to exceed \$150,000, for the period of January 1, 2018 through December 31, 2018, with the option to renew for two (2) additional one-year extensions, with escalations for the extensions to be limited to an amount equal to the increase in the previous year's Consumer Price Index (U.S. City Average CPI-U from the Bureau of Labor Statistics).

Environmental assessments were completed for this action and it was determined that there would be no significant effect on the environment.

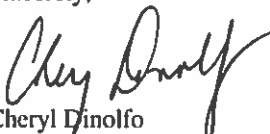
Funding for these services, consistent with authorized uses, is included in various capital funds fund(s). No additional net County support is required in the current Monroe County budget.
