## AUTHORIZING CONTRACT WITH CORRECTIONAL CONSULTING, INC. FOR MONITORING OF INMATE MEDICAL AND MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE COUNTY OF MONROE, as follows:

Section 1. The County Executive, or her designee, is hereby authorized to execute a contract, and any amendments thereto, with Correctional Consulting, Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$50,000, for the review, auditing and monitoring of contract performance by the Sheriff's inmate medical and mental health services provider, and the provision of written reports and recommendations regarding the performance of the medical and mental health services provided to the inmates in the custody of the Sheriff, for the period of April 1, 2017 through March 31, 2018, with the option to renew for two (2) additional one-year periods upon the mutual consent of the parties, in an amount not to exceed \$50,000 per year.

Section 2. Funding for this contract is included in the 2017 operating budget of the Sheriff's Office, general fund 9001, funds center 3804090000, Sheriff Jail Medical, and will be requested in future years' budgets.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect in accordance with Section C2-7 of the Monroe County Charter.

Honorable Legislators:

This matter is being referred to Your Honorable Body at the request of Sheriff Patrick M. O'Flynn.

I recommend that Your Honorable Body authorize a contract with Correctional Consulting, Inc. (CCI), in an amount not to exceed \$50,000, for the review, auditing and monitoring of contract performance by the Sheriff's inmate medical and mental health services provider, and the provision of written reports and recommendations regarding the performance of the medical and mental health services provided to the inmates in the custody of the Sheriff, for the period of April 1, 2017 through March 31, 2018, with the option to renew for two (2) additional one-year periods, upon mutual consent of the parties, in an amount not to exceed \$50,000 per year.

Established in 2006, CCI provides contract monitoring of medical and mental health services in a jail or prison setting. For the past 10 years CCI has performed contract monitoring services for the Monroe County Sheriff as part of its Inmate Medical and Mental Health Contract.

A Request for Qualifications was issued for this service with Correctional Consulting, Inc. selected as the most qualified to provide this service.

The specific legislative action required is to authorize the County Executive, or her designee, to execute a contract, and any amendments thereto with, Correctional Consulting, Inc., 9087 NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street, Coral Springs, Florida 33071, in an amount not to exceed \$50,000, for the review, auditing and monitoring of contract performance by the Sheriff's inmate medical and mental health services provider, and the provision of written reports and recommendations regarding the performance of the medical and mental health services provided to the inmates in the custody of the Sheriff, for the period of April 1, 2017 through March 31, 2018, with the option to renew for two (2) additional one-year periods upon the mutual consent of the parties, in an amount not to exceed \$50,000 per year.

Environmental assessments were completed for this action and it was determined that there would be no significant effect on the environment.

Funding for this contract is included in the 2017 operating budget of the Sheriff's Office, general fund 9001, funds center 3804090000, Sheriff Jail Medical and will be requested in future years budgets. No additional net County support is required in the current Monroe County budget.

The records in the office of the Monroe County Treasury have indicated that neither Correctional Consulting, Inc., nor its principal officers, Michal D. Murphy, President, and Barbara H. Murphy, Secretary, owe any delinquent Monroe County property taxes.

I recommend that this matter be referred to the appropriate committee(s) for favorable action by Your Honorable Body.
