Honorable Legislators:

I recommend that Your Honorable Body authorize a contract with the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation for Monroe County to maintain custody and utilize an oil spill response trailer and equipment, for the period of March 14, 2017 through March 14, 2027.

This contract will help to enhance the availability of spill response resources in Monroe County that could be employed to mitigate a number of hazardous material based spill scenarios including those associated with a crude oil incident along the CSX rail corridor. This oil spill response trailer and equipment will be stored at Monroe County's Fleet Center on Paul Road, along with the County's supplemental hazardous materials response resources.

The specific legislative action required is to authorize the County Executive, or her designee, to execute a contract, and any amendments thereto, with the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation, for Monroe County to maintain custody and utilize an oil spill response trailer and equipment, for the period of March 14, 2017 through March 14, 2027.

Environmental assessments were completed for this action and it was determined that there would be no significant effect on the environment.

This contract will have no impact on the revenues or expenditures of the current Monroe County budget.
