Honorable Legislators:

I recommend that Your Honorable Body authorize a contract with Barton & Loguidice D.P.C., in the amount of \$31,700, for professional engineering services, for the Hall of Justice Courtroom Improvements Project.

The Monroe County Hall of Justice (HOJ) is located within the County's Civic Center Complex, 99 Exchange Boulevard, Rochester, New York. The project includes reconstruction of approximately 5,000 square feet of former library space located on the fifth floor of the HOJ, including interior renovations and reconfigurations to meet the functional needs of the New York State Unified Court System. This project will result in two (2) new court rooms, office and support space. This initial phase will include preliminary design services for the project.

Several consultants were considered, with Barton & Loguidice D.P.C. rated the most qualified to provide professional design services for the project. Barton & Loguidice D.P.C. proposes to provide basic design and special services in the amount of \$31,700. A cost breakdown of these services is as follows:

Basic Design Services \$ 27,100 Special Services \$ 4,600 Total \$ 31,700

The specific legislative action required is to authorize the County Executive, or her designee, to execute a contract with Barton & Loguidice D.P.C., 11 Centre Park, Suite 203, Rochester, NY 14614, in the amount of \$31,700, for professional engineering services, for the Hall of Justice Courtroom Improvements Project, and any amendments necessary to complete the project within the total capital fund(s) appropriation.

Environmental assessments were completed for this action and it was determined that there would be no significant effect on the environment.

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Funding for this contract, consistent with authorized uses, is included in capital fund 1834 and any capital fund(s) created for the same intended purpose. No additional net County support is required in the current Monroe County budget.

The records in the Office of the Monroe County Treasury have indicated that neither Barton & Loguidice D.P.C., nor any of its principal officers, owe any delinquent Monroe County property taxes. The principal officers of the firm are:
