Honorable Legislators:

I recommend that Your Honorable Body authorize an intermunicipal agreement with the Spencerport Fire District for the storage and transport of Special Operations Unit Trailer Fleet #5121.

This Special Operations Unit Trailer houses a 2015 John Deer Model XUV 855D off-road vehicle known as Fire Bureau Unit 8037 and related support equipment for land-based search and rescue operations. This unit responds on all activations of the Monroe County Special Operations Unit (technical rescue unit) within the community and is an added resource for incidents along the rail and canal corridors where access can be limited.

The specific legislative action required is to authorize the County Executive, or her designee, to execute an intermunicipal agreement, and any amendments thereto, with the Spencerport Fire District for the storage and transport of Special Operations Unit Trailer Fleet #5121.
