Authorize a Contract with T.Y. Lin International Engineering, Architecture & Land Surveying, P.C. for Engineering Services for the Highway Lighting Rehabilitation Northwest 2 Project in the Towns of Gates and Greece

Honorable Legislators:

I recommend that Your Honorable Body authorize a contract with T.Y. Lin International Engineering, Architecture & Land Surveying, P.C., in the amount of \$199,668.52, for engineering services, for the Highway Lighting Rehabilitation Northwest 2 Project in the Towns of Gates and Greece.

This project involves the rehabilitation of the Highway Lighting on I-390 north of Brooks Ave. to I-490 including the interchange with Chili Ave. and NY Route 390 from Lexington Ave. to NY Route 104 including the interchanges with Lexington Ave., Ridgeway Ave. and NY Route 104 in the Towns of Gates and Greece. The project will involve the replacement of some lighting poles, the replacement of the lighting conduit system and electrical wires, as well as upgrade of the system to LED lights and installing a lighting management system. The current total project estimate is \$2,200,000.

Several consultants were considered, with T.Y. Lin International Engineering, Architecture & Land Surveying, P.C. rated the most qualified for this project. T.Y. Lin International Engineering, Architecture & Land Surveying, P.C. proposes to provide these services in the amount of \$199,668.52.

A cost breakdown of these services is as follows:

Design Services	\$155,036.92
Special Services	26,944.49
Construction Phase Services	17,687.11
Total	\$199,668.52

The specific legislative action required is to authorize the County Executive, or her designee, to execute a contract with T.Y. Lin International Engineering, Architecture & Land Surveying, P.C., 255 East Avenue, Rochester, New York 14604, in the amount of \$199,668.52, for engineering services, for the Highway Lighting Rehabilitation Northwest 2 Project in the Towns of Gates and Greece, and any amendments necessary to complete the project within the total capital fund(s) appropriation.

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Environmental assessments were completed for this action and it was determined that there would be no significant effect on the environment.

Funding for this contract, consistent with authorized uses, is included in capital fund 1830 and any capital fund(s) created for the same intended purpose. No additional net County support is required in the current Monroe County budget.

The records in the Office of the Monroe County Treasury have indicated that neither T.Y. Lin International Engineering, Architecture & Land Surveying, P.C., nor any of its principal officers, owe any delinquent Monroe County property taxes. The principal officers of the firm are:
