Subject: Authorize an Amendment of the County Road System Map

Honorable Legislators:

I recommend that Your Honorable Body authorize an amendment of the County road system map.

The New York State Department of Transportation is updating the public road mileage for all municipalities in New York State for the Federal Highway Administration in a geospatial format to use in a Geographic Information System. The update has included an informational meeting and a comprehensive review of all roadways and their lengths in the Local Highway Inventory. As part of the update for Monroe County, several road segments have been identified as eligible to be added to our inventory and subsequently to be included for highway maintenance funding distribution purposes. The following roadway segments are eligible and are proposed to be added to the official County Highway Map:

Road	From	To	Town	Length
Park Road	Corwin Road	North Landing Road	Brighton	0.17 mi.
Horseshoe Road	Kings Highway	Lakeshore Blvd.	Irondequoit	0.24 mi.

South Glen Road	Bay Front South	Glen Haven Road	Irondequoit	0.16 mi.
Hopkins Point Road	Clover Street	Canfield Road	Mendon	1.08 mi.
Corduoy Road	Woolston Road	Park Road	Perinton	0.56 mi.
Total				2.75 mi.

Therefore, the Monroe County Director of Transportation recommends the corresponding amendment of the County road system map under Highway Law Section 115.


The specific legislative action required is to authorize an amendment of the County road system map to include: Park Road, Corwin Road to North Landing Road; Horseshoe Road, Kings Highway to Lakeshore Blvd.; Bay Front South, Orchard Park Blvd. to South Glen Road; South Glen Road, Bay Front South to Glen Haven Road; Hopkins Point Road, Clover Street to Canfield Road; and Corduroy Road, Woolston Road to Park Road.

Environmental assessments were completed for this action and it was determined that there would be no significant effect on the environment.

This amendment will have no impact on the revenues and expenditures of the current Monroe County budget.

I recommend that this matter be referred to the appropriate committee(s) for favorable action by Your Honorable Body.

I recommend that Your Honorable Body authorize the acquisition of interests in real property for the installation and maintenance of traffic signal equipment at the entrance to 4255 East River Road in the Town of Henrietta from the property owners described as follows:

The specific legislative action required is to authorize the County Executive, or her designee, to acquire the referenced property interests and execute all documents necessary for the installation and maintenance of traffic signal equipment at the entrance to 4255 East River Road, tax identification # 174.03-2-1.111, in the Town of Henrietta by contract and/or the Eminent Domain Procedure Law, along with any amendments for unanticipated damages, within the total operating account appropriation.

Environmental assessments were completed for this action and it was determined that there would be no significant effect on the environment.


Funding for this acquisition is included in the 2016 operating budget of the Department of Transportation, fund 9002, funds center 8004030000, Signal Maintenance and Operations. No additional net County support is required in the current Monroe County budget.

The specific legislative action required is to authorize the County Executive, or her designee, to acquire the referenced property interests and execute all documents necessary for the culvert replacement project over Little Black Creek Tributary on Coldwater Road at tax identification numbers 133.11-1-29, 133.10-1-46 and 133.10-1-32.11, in the Town of Gates by contract and/or the Eminent Domain Procedure Law, along with any amendments for unanticipated damages, within the total capital fund(s) appropriation.

Environmental assessments were completed for this action and it was determined that there would be no significant effect on the environment.

Funding for these acquisitions, consistent with authorized uses, is included in capital fund 1701 and any capital fund(s) created for the same intended purpose. No additional net County support is required in the current Monroe County budget.

The records in the Office of the Monroe County Treasury have indicated that the property owners listed above do not owe any delinquent Monroe County property taxes. The principal officer of RM Equity Holdings, LLC is Robert M. Marcello, Managing Member.
