## **COMIDA REVOKES INCENTIVES FOR HENRIETTA LODGING**

Due to inquiries by the Rochester Building Trades, working cooperatively with COMIDA, COMIDA today revoked all benefits for Henrietta Lodging, effective immediately, due to non-compliance with the agency's local labor requirement. The value of the benefits is just over \$100,000 in property and sales tax abatements.

The benefits were revoked following COMIDA's ongoing monitoring of agency-approved construction projects. A recent inspection found violations of the local labor requirement.

COMIDA-approved construction projects require that local laborers working on the job must reside in the following six-county region: Monroe, Genesee, Livingston, Orleans, Ontario, and Wayne. COMIDA regularly monitors all agency-approved construction projects for compliance with the requirement.
