### **BROOKS: JETBLUE ANNOUNCES NON-STOP SERVICE TO ORLANDO**

Monroe County Executive Maggie Brooks today announced that JetBlue Airways will expand their flight service at the Greater Rochester International Airport (GRIA) with a seasonal non-stop flight to Orlando, Florida beginning November 15, 2007.

*“The Greater Rochester International Airport is thrilled to welcome JetBlue Airways’ new non-stop service to Orlando. This is more good news for area travelers,”* said Monroe County Executive **Maggie Brooks**. *“Thanks to the addition of low-fare carriers like JetBlue Airways, our airport has experienced record growth and continues to attract affordable service to major cities.”*

Brooks said nearly 15 percent of all passengers who fly out of GRIA use JetBlue Airways, making it the third most-traveled airline out of Rochester.

*“Today we’re proud to add non-stop flights from Buffalo, Rochester and Portland to Orlando just in time for snowbird season,”* said **Marty St. George**, JetBlue’s vice president of network planning. *“The customer response to our low-fare service in all three Northeast cities has been tremendous, so it just makes sense to offer more of the low-fare service our customers have been asking for.”*
