Legislative Update (Legislators Yudelson, Delehanty and Milne):

Monroe County/Town of Pittsford Food Scraps Collection Pilot Program (Referral 23-0239) passed 28-1, bipartisan support

Tomorrow Full Legislature – Referral 23-0266 – Climate Smart Communities (CSC) grant acceptance for Climate Vulnerability Assessment/Climate Adaptation Plan; whereas CAP focuses on mitigation, the Climate Adaptation and Resilience Plan (CARP) will focus on resilience/adaption; passed through August committees

 - Waste Landfill, recycling/compost
 - o Agriculture, Forestry, & Land Use Land use changes; agriculture (livestock/fertilizer)

 - Largest sector: transportation/mobile sources, 36.64%; followed by industrial and residential energy
