

**MONROE COUNTY** residents may recycle their Christmas trees at the following locations. Residents save a valuable resource by having trees chipped into landscape mulch instead of disposing of them in local landfills.

Please remember to <u>remove all decorations</u>, <u>plastic bags</u>, <u>wires and nails</u> from trees to avoid damage to equipment. Where chipping is available, residents should check with their municipality for giveback programs - and <u>bring their own containers</u>.
