

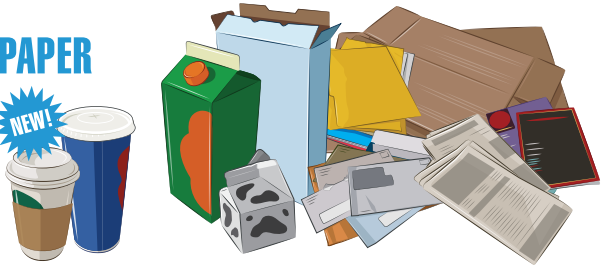

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q | Can I recycle all plastics marked #1- #7?

A | *The recycling symbol and/or numbers does not necessarily indicate recyclability. **Recycle plastics by their SHAPE: empty to-go cups, bottles, jars, jugs & tubs.** Black plastic and compostable plastic are not accepted, regardless of shape.*

Q | What types of cups are acceptable?

A | ***Paper cups: hot or cold**, with paper sleeves (like a coffee cup) and **Plastic to-go cups: clear or white** (like iced coffee or soda), are now accepted for recycling. For recyclable cups, first empty all contents then reattach lid. Discard any straws and stir sticks. **Colored plastic party cups are NOT accepted.***



Q | Should I separate my recyclables using plastic bags?

A | ***NO, Keep recyclables unbagged and loose in container.***



Q | Can I recycle caps and lids from containers?

A | ***After rinsing, caps and lids should be reattached.***

Q | Can I recycle foam egg cartons, coffee cups, and packing material?

A | ***No, foam cannot be placed in recycling bins.***



Q | Can I place small electronics in my recycling bin or TVs and the like at the curb?

A | ***No, but they can be brought to electronic recyclers for free recycling.***

Q | Can pizza boxes be recycled?

A | ***Yes, pizza boxes can be recycled.***
Grease is OK, as long as no food is remaining.
