Dear Neighbor:

Monroe County plans to replace the existing culvert carrying **Schlegel Road over Fourmile Creek Tributary** in 2026. This culvert is approximately 1300' west of Basket Road.

The existing culvert was originally constructed in 1987. The culvert has been inspected regularly and has been deemed by the Department of Transportation to be near the end of its useful service life. The culvert is proposed to be replaced with a precast concrete box culvert.

Construction is scheduled to begin in the Spring of 2026. During that time, Schlegel Road will be closed to vehicular and pedestrian traffic at the culvert site. Detours will be posted around the closure utilizing Salt Road, Woodard Road, and Basket Road. The project is estimated to take approximately 3 months to complete. Additional information will be sent out at least 2 weeks before the planned road closure.
