Dear Neighbor:

Monroe County plans to replace the existing bridge carrying **Moscow Road over Yanty Creek** in the Town of Hamlin. This bridge is located approximately 1 mile east of Redman Road.

The existing bridge was originally constructed in 1932. The bridge has been inspected regularly and has been deemed by the Monroe County Department of Transportation to be near the end of its useful life. The existing bridge is proposed to be replaced with a new concrete structure.

Construction is scheduled to begin in the spring of 2027. During that time, Moscow Road will be closed to vehicular and pedestrian traffic at the bridge site. A signed detour will be posted via Redman Road, Jacobs Road, and Priem Road.

The project is estimated to take approximately 5 months to complete. Additional information will be sent out in the spring of 2027 in advance of the planned road closure.

MOSCOW ROAD BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT

OVER YANTY CREEK (BIN 3317110, SIN 06-2115-246)
TOWN OF HAMLIN, MONROE COUNTY, NEW YORK



Project Description

- The project proposes to replace a structurally deficient bridge on Moscow Road, located approximately 1 mile east of Redman Road, in the Town of Hamlin.

Project Objective

- Address structural and hydraulic deficiencies to meet current standards.

Proposed Improvements: Bridge Replacement

- Complete removal of the existing, 2-span bridge.
- Installation of a new, 40-ft single-span, prestressed concrete beam bridge.
- Placement of stone fill slope protection for prevention of erosion and scour.
- Full reconstruction of the road section immediately adjacent to the bridge structure; consisting of 11-ft travel lanes.
- Due to right-of-way constraints with the NYS parkland to the north, a 4-ft shoulder will be installed on the north side of the road (westbound traffic) and a 6-ft shoulder on the south side (eastbound traffic).
- Installation of new bridge rail and box-beam guide rail.
- Refer to the back of this letter for preliminary plan layout of the proposed bridge structure.

Maintenance and Protection of Traffic

- The project will require closure of Moscow Road.
- Local traffic will be maintained up to the bridge.
- Through traffic will follow the 4 mile long detour route (as shown above) for the duration of construction (approx.. 5 months).

Right of Way

- The acquisition of Easements along portions of the properties adjacent will be required.
- The easements will be needed for construction of the bridge and for future maintenance of the bridge.
- Affected property owners will be contacted during preliminary design.

Tentative Schedule & Costs

- Preliminary Design: Ongoing
- Final Design: Fall 2026
- Start Construction: Spring 2027
- Complete Construction: Fall 2027
- Estimated Construction Costs: \$1.8 Million
- Project Funded: NYS "BridgeNY" program and Monroe County Funding
