CURRENT PROJECT STATUS

WORK TO BEGIN ON CULVER ROAD ON OR AROUND JUNE 02, 2025

As part of Monroe County Department of Transportation's Highway Preventive Maintenance #11 Project, the contractor, Keeler Construction Corporation, Inc., is scheduled to begin roadwork on **Culver Road from Norton Street to it's northern limit at the Irondequoit Bay Outlet Bridge**.

Construction will begin on Culver Road on or around June 2. Work will include:

- Reconstruction of some sidewalk curb ramps to make them ADA compliant
- · Repairs to some existing curb and drainage inlets where needed
- Milling and re-paving of the top layer of asphalt along with installation of new pavement markings

Typical work operations will allow for two-way traffic to be maintained with daily lane closures, as needed. Flaggers may be utilized to guide traffic around work zones.

As part of these improvements, **Culver Road from Bursen Street to Whitlock Road** will be re-striped in order to reduce the number of travel lanes and add a center turning lane along with wider shoulders. The center turn lane will better accommodate vehicles making left turns, and the wider shoulders will better accommodate bicycles and deliveries along this corridor. Overall work on Culver Road is expected to be completed by mid-August. The work will be performed during daytime hours. The long project duration is due to the large number of sidewalk curb ramps that need replacement to make them ADA compliant.




EXISTING CULVER ROAD LANE LAYOUT
