This informational newsletter will provide updates (as needed) on the status of the Highway Preventive Maintenance #11 Project and communicate upcoming construction activities to local residents.

CURRENT PROJECT STATUS

CONSTRUCTION UNDERWAY ON EAST RIDGE ROAD

As part of Monroe County Department of Transportation's Highway Preventive Maintenance #11 Project, the contractor, Keeler Construction Company, Inc., will be continuing roadwork on East Ridge Road from Seneca Avenue to Culver Road.

Construction will continue on East Ridge Road through the months of September and October. Work will include:

- Reconstruction of some sidewalk curb ramps to make them ADA compliant
- Repairs to some existing curb and drainage inlets where needed
- Milling and re-paving of the top layer of asphalt along with installation of new pavement markings
- Adjustments to manholes, valves and drainage structures in the roadway

Typical work operations will allow for two-way traffic to be maintained with daily lane closures, as needed. Flaggers may be utilized to guide traffic around work zones.

Overall work on East Ridge Road is expected to be completed by the end of October. The sidewalk curb ramp reconstruction, curb repairs, drainage repairs and adjustments will be performed during daytime hours. Milling and paving operations will be performed during nighttime hours.
