NOTICE OF VIRTUAL PUBLIC HEARING

As part of its public participation process, Monroe County Community Development is required to hold at least one public hearing to prepare for the upcoming Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Emergency Solutions Grants (ESG) and HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME) Program application process. Please note that the application process for the 2021-2022 HOME Investment Partnerships Program Affordable Housing request for proposals was released earlier this year to assist affordable housing developers in preparing their funding applications to New York State Housing and Community Renewal. Those applications were due December 4, 2020. A second public hearing will be held in May during the 30-day public comment period on proposed projects.

Monroe County welcomes your comments on community development projects and activities.

The CDBG application packets will be available on January 7th. **The submission deadline for applications is Friday, February 12, 2021 at 4:00 p.m.** The applications will also be available on the Community Development page of the County website at www.monroecounty.gov.

Monroe County has not yet received notification from HUD in regard to the 2021 allocations. For planning purposes, we will proceed based on funding received in 2020, which made \$3 million available for the CDBG, ESG and HOME programs.
