## Trevon McKinnon Pled Guilty to Manslaughter in the First Degree

Rochester, NY- Today, 20 year old Trevon McKinnon pled guilty to Manslaughter in the First Degree and admitted to his role in the November 11, 2014 shooting death of Jamall Chester. On that day, McKinnon and his five co-defendants went to 26 Ludwig Park in the City of Rochester. McKinnon admitted that he and one other co-defendant approached the house with the intent to commit a robbery of the occupants. While at the door, the two men opened fire on Jamall Chester, striking him three times. Mr. Chester died at the scene.

The case was prosecuted by Julie Hahn, Chief of the Non Violent Felony Bureau and Assistant District Attorney Jennifer Hyatt of the Special Investigations Bureau.

"As a result of today's guilty plea, Trevon McKinnon will spend 20 years in prison, with an additional 5 years post release supervision," said Bureau Chief Julie Hahn. "It is our hope that the victim's family can begin to heal knowing McKinnon is no longer free to share the streets of our community."

Trevon McKinnon will be sentenced by County Court Judge Vincent Dinolfo on May 25, 2016. Indictments against his co-defendants are still pending.
