

SCHLEGEL ROAD CULVERT REPLACEMENT PROJECT

OVER FOURMILE CREEK TRIBUTARY TOWN OF WEBSTER, MONROE COUNTY, NEW YORK



Project Description

 The project proposes to replace a structurally deficient culvert on Schlegel Road, located approximately 1/2 mile east of Salt Road, in the Town of Webster.

Project Objective

 Address structural and hydraulic deficiencies to meet current standards and provide a service life of at least 70 years.

Proposed Improvements: Culvert Replacement

- Complete removal of the existing twin pipe culvert.
- Installation of a new, single 15' wide x 4' high precast concrete box culvert.
- Placement of stone fill at the ends of the culvert for erosion protection.
- Full reconstruction of the road section immediately adjacent to the culvert structure; consisting of 11-ft. travel lanes. A 6ft shoulder will be installed on both sides of the road at the culvert.
- Refer to the back of this letter for preliminary plan layout of the proposed culvert structure.

Maintenance and Protection of Traffic

 The project will require closure of Schlegel Road at the project limits for approximately 3 months. A detour will be posted for through traffic, but the road will be open to local traffic up to the culvert. The culvert will not be crossable. The posted detour will utilize Salt Road, Woodard Rd and Basket Road.

Right of Way

 There are no anticipated new easements for this project. The project will be constructed within the existing easements and highway boundary.

Tentative Schedule & Costs

• Preliminary Design: Ongoing

• Final Design: Fall 2025

• Start Construction: Spring 2026

• Complete Construction: Summer 2026

• Estimated Construction Costs: \$600,000
