RE: **PUBLIC NOTICE: UPCOMING ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS ON THOMAS AVENUE**

Dear Neighbor,

Monroe County is planning roadway improvements along Thomas Avenue, between St. Paul Boulevard and Pattonwood Drive in the Town of Irondequoit. This project is essential for enhancing safety, accessibility, and roadway conditions in the area.

Project Highlights:

- Pavement rehabilitation to improve driving conditions.
- New shoulders to better accommodate bicycles, deliveries, and emergency stops.
- Replacement of existing concrete gutters with new curbing.
- Upgraded storm sewer infrastructure to address deterioration.
- New sidewalk installation on the north/east side of Thomas Avenue between Eaton Road and Mt. Airey Drive, filling in a current gap.
- Installation of a Rapid Rectangular Flashing Beacon (RRFB) at the Eaton Road crosswalk to improve pedestrian safety.
- Traffic signal upgrades at the intersection of St. Paul Boulevard and Thomas Avenue to meet current standards.
