CURRENT PROJECT STATUS

CONSTRUCTION UNDERWAY ON STONE ROAD (GREECE), OCTOBER 2025

As part of Monroe County Department of Transportation's Highway Preventive Maintenance #11 Project, the contractor, Keeler Construction Company, Inc., has recently began sidewalk curb ramp replacements on **Stone Road from Mount Read Boulevard to Lynette Drive.**

Milling and Paving operations will begin the week of October 13, 2025 and finish in approximately 2 weeks, weather permitting.

Work includes:

- Reconstruction of some sidewalk curb ramps to make them ADA compliant
- · Improvements to the roadway shoulder
- Adjustments to manholes, drainage inlets and valves
- · Milling and re-paving of the top layer of asphalt along with installation of new pavement markings

Typical work operations will allow for two-way traffic to be maintained with daily lane closures, as needed. Flaggers may be utilized to guide traffic around work zones.

Overall work on Stone Road is expected to be completed by the end of October. The work will be performed during daytime hours.
