SENIORS: Call 2-1-1 (LIFELINE)

LIFELINE is a 24/7 service that can help refer seniors to the appropriate agency for a ride to the polls. To avoid long wait times, please try to call after normal business hours.

STAR

If you are already enrolled, you can sign up or schedule your ride. STAR provides services to people 60+ years of age.

EISEP

Can provide rides to the polls for *EISEP enrolled clients only*. Clients should work directly with their care manager.

There is wheelchair transport available with EISEP Ancillary funds.

RTS

For voters who use RTS, they can take advantage of the early voting location at the old SUNY Brockport Building, 55 St Paul St. For those who live in areas not well served by RTS buses, RTS is making On Demand vehicles available. Voters who need a ride should call Board of Elections at 753-1550.
