From the outset, Monroe County set in place a monthly compliance review over the life of the multi-year grant for the Neighborhood Collaborative Project (NCP). While no oversight structure is foolproof, it can limit the extent of mismanagement or malfeasance, as it did in this case.

The County awarded NCP the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds by RFP, which included the Community Resource collaborative (CRC) as the fiscal agent as part of the RFP response. Prior to the ARPA award, the CRC oversaw multiple successful community programs.

With full transparency, the Administration announced the funding discrepancy within hours of its discovery and immediately froze ARPA funding to the NCP and ordered an investigation and forensic audit.

As to Legislator Barnhart's letter to the Department of Justice and subsequent accusations of a lack of diligence on this contract, the County been in contact with state and federal authorities.

Last year, Legislator Barnhart reviewed every American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) proposal, including the Neighborhood Resource Collaborative project using the Community Resource collaborative (CRC) as the fiscal agent.

Following Legislator Barnhart's review of the plan, she voted in favor of its passage and raised no issue about the CRC. Last week, she posted on X that she "felt the county process was good and thorough."

Please note BTS exceeds its budgeted allocation for neighborhood client wraparound services with this submission. Our experience to date has demonstrated a great need for the services rendered through BTS and we fully expect this need will continue throughout the remainder of 2023. Fortunately, C3 does not anticipate utilizing its full budgeted allocation for neighborhood ambassador services in 2023. Given both of these allocations are aligned with NCP's intent to provide needed support services to neighborhood residents, we anticipate ~\$30K from C3's neighborhood ambassador budget allocation may be needed to offset the current and anticipated excess for BTS wraparound services. While we remain within target for our overall project spending, we will continue to monitor this activity closely and welcome your suggestions and guidance.





We understand that this number could vary, but we need a commitment every quarter to a number of residents you plan to serve. Please indicate in this cell or in a separate line the total number or residents you plan to serve with your program in that quarter over all NCP areas. This should not be a range- this should be a clearly defined number and should correlate with the number given in your scope- 5,200.

We also need to know about the specific programs and services you plan to offer and when you plan to offer them. Beyond engagement walks and pop-up events-If you are planning to address food insecurity, behavioral health service etc- please indicate how you plan to do this and what services you will be offering to the community in the action item sheet. Legal will want this clearly defined in your contract. The action item sheet should mirror your scope and should be detailed regarding the services you plan to provide to the community.

Per your project management and fiscal reporting, we expect that these amounts would get rolled into the cost of doing the project. They are the general administrative fees that correspond with the work so they can be added to the costs of that work and divided evenly. The reason for this email is on behalf of our fiscal sponsor, Community Resource Collaborative (CRC). To date, all of the County Executive Office's media and printed communication regarding the ARPA awards has inaccurately purported that CRC is the proposed recipient of the award instead of accurately reflecting that CRC is solely the fiscal sponsor on behalf of the Neighborhood Collaborative Project. Unfortunately, this subtle nuance has caused CRC to not receive a pending grant award from Excellus BCBS because they mistakenly believe CRC has been awarded \$7.1M from the County Executive's Office.

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

Ann, thank you for reaching out and sharing your feedback. Forgive my long and what I hope is a thorough response, but I want to make sure we understand each other around this issue of equitable distribution of funding. First, let me say that It is my understanding that the list had not made it through the legislative approval and voting process yet, and that the funds allocation was set for 2023 when that process concludes. I believe that part of the anxiety is the premature release of information regarding these organizations and communications that were sent out. That part is for the politicians to figure out.

I am attaching an article that I think would be essential for you to read as we engage this issue and concerns around our call for equitable funding distrubution. Please know that I am available to talk more about this anytime you are available. My direct number is 585-966-9082. I realize that email is probably not the best way to communicate, such an emotional topic around race and equity, so I hope we can talk more.

When we spoke of racial equity and equitable dispensation of AARPA funds, we are talking about the disproportionate designation of those funds to White led and owned organizations in comparison to Black ones, which is indisputable and remains a huge problem not only in our county, but in our city as well, when it comes to funding allocations, grant requests etc. as I have been in conversation with black led organizations for the last two years listening to their concerns. As a side note, did you know for example that there is not one Black led organizational contract with the county to house the street homeless?

As Black pastors, we don't want to be the ones who have to call for justice around this, but someone has too or nothing will change. In the best scenario we would like for white led organizations to pose these questions with us as they seek funding. While we acknowledge the good work white led organizations are doing, it is a

paternalistic model that often leaves Black led organizations off the board to work effectively in their own communities as credible messengers, and culturally relevant service providers. The call for justice should not be seen as an affront to work like yours, but an expansion of it to include Black led organizations who are also seeking to do good work. Equity benefits us all.

As we stood before the media cameras, our thought was that we would also like the Monroe County legislature and County Executives office to be a place where Black led and owned organizations receive the same funding consideration that white led and owned organizations do. Repeatedly, they do not. In our county and city, it is preferred that white organizations are trusted and invested in to take care of people of color through their programs, while investments in Black led organizations to take care of people of color are minimal investments at best beyond the three on this list. Yet, Black voters like white voters have gone to the polls to pull levers for these same leaders and deserve the same consideration and opportunities. When paternalism is the preferred model over an equitable one, it becomes a racist model for service delivery and funding.

It is why I and many of these Black pastors have shown up at their meetings fighting for things like redistricting maps that are directly connected to resources in both Black and white communities. As you know the result was that it was vetoed by Bello and the Black community was paternalized saying we didn't deserve any more representation and that we are in essence "effectively black". While I am still working to get a map that will enfranchise the collective black community, I know that representation is always tied to resources.

I and these Black pastors returned again to this legislature to support the appointment of a Black led Public Defender's office and again, this legislature with Bello's support voted it down, even though he was deemed the highest qualified by the hiring committee, but instead, they created an alternate process to maintain a transparent preference for whiteness in its appointment of Julie Cianca who was previously voted down by the legislative committee that we as Black pastors bore witness to with our own eyes. This was another slap in the face of Black Pastors, the Black community, and Black leaders calling for equity and inclusion.

Now, a list of recipients have been selected with disproportionate representation again of the Black community as it relates to Black led and owned organization dollar allocation. It is rumored to include political patrons who allegedly gave funds to the Bello campaign.

The fact is that out of the list of 40 organizations, only 5 are potentially black led and owned organizations, with any significant investment given. That is not our idea of equitable distribution of funds and these patterns of racial injustice is what we as Black pastors pointed out at our press conference.

So, while this fight may seem merely political to you and that we don't have adequate information, I assure you that there is more at stake here than politics, and assumed ignorance on our part. There is a much bigger picture of equity and inclusion

happening here in our County that must be addressed in an ongoing manner. We are not against your organization receiving its funding or ours. We are a church with a commitment to anti-racism along with the Black pastors who stood with me and these issues are important in leaning into that commitment.

There is a quotes that have been helpful to me in this by John Stewart Mill that says, "He should not be lulled to repose by the delusion that he does no harm who takes no part in public affairs. He should know that bad men need no better opportunity than when good men look on and do nothing. He should stand to his principles even if leaders go wrong."

While we don't designate these folks as inherently bad, we do designate the place where decisions are being made as coming from a bad place if anti-blackness and structural racism continues to be a running theme in decision making and resource allocation.

Dear Rev. Myra,

I was very upset to see a story on Channel 13, where a group of local Black pastors claimed that the Federal ARPA funds have somehow been distributed inequitably. The Reentry Association of WNY is one of the grant recipients (or will be, if the County Legislature ever let it come up for a vote). We work with men and women coming out of jails and prisons to ensure they can stabilize in the community and receive the services they and their families need. A portion of our funds are going to Spiritus Christi's Mental Health program. The application process was long and thorough, and the scoring of applications was determined by the Federal government. Over 25 years in non-profit work, I've applied for scores of grants and I can sincerely say I've never been through a more grueling, detailed application process. Sadly, this has turned into a political fight between Sabrina LaMar and Adam Bello, that is accomplishing nothing but punishing the most vulnerable people in our community. Please consider reaching out to someone who knows the facts:
