The Monroe County District Attorney's Office is actively recruiting entry-level and experienced attorneys to join our team serving a community of more than 750,000 residents.



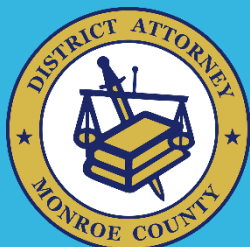

## Notable Court Appearances

78-year-old **Robert Mear** pled guilty to the indictment, which included Vehicular Assault in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree and two counts of Driving While Intoxicated. He will be sentenced in front of New York State Supreme Court Justice Argento on April 14, 2026. This case was prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Merrick Sadler, Chief of the Vehicular Crimes Bureau, and Assistant District Attorney Diana Ferretti, also of the Vehicular crimes Bureau.

64-year-old **Larry Neal** was arraigned on one count of Aggravated Cruelty to Animals. He will be back on court in front of Monroe County Court Judge Douglas Randall on April 7, 2026, for motions.,

41-year-old **Christopher Meranda** was indicted on three counts of Burglary in the 1<sup>st</sup> Degree, two counts of Assault in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree, Aggravated Criminal Contempt, two counts of Criminal Contempt in the 1<sup>st</sup> Degree, Criminal Mischief in the 4<sup>th</sup> Degree, three counts of Criminal Contempt in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree, and three counts of Criminal Mischief in the 4<sup>th</sup> Degree. This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Kenisha Flowers of the Special Victims Unit.

54-year-old **Katherine Gobble** pled guilty to Disorderly Conduct with a one-year conditional discharge, a two year No Contact Order of Protection for the Victim, and mandated counseling. This case was prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Rachel Wallisky, of the Local Courts Bureau.

23-year-old **Joshua Clemens** was indicted on Assault in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree in relation to the assault on a University of Rochester Department of Public Safety Officer on January 25, 2026. This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Ryan Lamon, of the Major Felony Bureau.

41-year-old **Antonio Maybell** was indicted on Assault in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree, Criminal Possession of a Firearm, and Menacing in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree in relation to an assault against a Rochester Police Officer on January 26, 2026. This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Kristin Sippel, of the Major Felony Bureau.

35-year-old **Jaqwan Shamar Wyatt** was indicted on three counts of Driving While Intoxicated. This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Merrick Sadler, Chief of the Vehicular Crimes Bureau.

19-year-old **Jacob Rivera** was indicted on three counts of Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree and three counts of Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree. This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Kristin Sippel, of the Major Felony Bureau.

## Ongoing & Upcoming Trials

The People vs. **Jamie Busch**

The Defendant is charged with Murder in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree and two counts of Tampering With Physical Evidence in front of New York State Supreme Court Justice Stephen Miller.

This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Jessica Wagner, of the Special Victims Unit.

The People vs. **Tyshon McCullough**

The Defendant is charged with Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree and Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree in front of Monroe County Court Judge Doug Randall.

This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Ryan Mulcahy, of the Special Investigations Bureau.

The People vs. **Jermaine Williams**

This defendant is charged with two counts of Murder in the 1<sup>st</sup> Degree and two counts of Murder in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree, in front of Monroe County Court Judge Michael Dollinger.

This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Adam VanHeyst, Deputy Chief of the Major Felony Bureau, and Assistant District Attorney Emily Chisholm, of the Non-Fatal Shooting Taskforce.

The People vs. **Brima Jalloh**

The Defendant is charged with Burglary in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree in front of Monroe County Court Judge Michael Ansaldi.

This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Camille Ingino, of the Major Felony Bureau.
