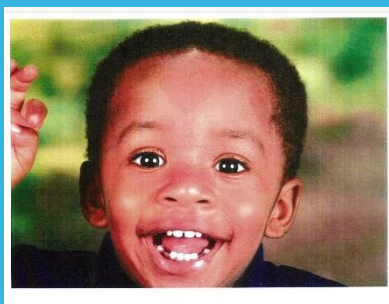

There are some cases that are difficult to put into words.

The death of any child is heartbreaking. Children should have the opportunity to grow up surrounded by people who love them, to feel safe and protected, and to experience all of the milestones that come with childhood. When a young life is lost, particularly at just two years old, that loss is felt far beyond one family. It affects an entire community.

Over the past several days, many people in our community have learned the name and seen the smiling face of **Isaiah Jones**. While there is very little I can say about the pending criminal case, I do want to say this: Isaiah was a sweet little boy who was deeply loved. As this case moves through the criminal justice system, we will not lose sight of the child at the center of it.

I have complete faith in Assistant District Attorney Hillary Langdon, Chief of our Special Victims Unit, and Special Assistant District Attorney Kaylee Rizzari, also of the Special Victims Unit. They are compassionate, experienced prosecutors who understand the tremendous responsibility that comes with handling a case involving the death of a child. Our office will carefully follow the evidence, uphold our obligations as prosecutors, and do everything within our authority to seek justice for Isaiah.

The next step in this case will be an arraignment in superior court. We will remember Isaiah, and we will do everything in our ability to seek justice.

MCDA In the Courtroom

46-year-old **Shawn Warnick** was indicted on Manslaughter in the 2nd Degree in relation to the death of Timothy Lee Carlton. This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Courtney Kleiman, of the Special Victims Unit.

30-year-old **Kevin Williams** was indicted on Burglary in the 1st Degree, Strangulation in the 2nd Degree, two counts of Assault in the 3rd Degree, three counts of Endangering the Welfare of a Child, and three counts of Criminal Mischief in the 4th Degree. This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Kenisha Flowers, of the Special Victims Unit.

33-year-old **Jazmine Barnes** was indicted on Burglary in the 2nd Degree. This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Camille Ingino, of the Major Felony Bureau.

30-year-old **Sean Fagan** was indicted on Attempted Murder in the 2nd Degree, Assault in the 2nd Degree, Criminal Obstruction of Breathing or Blood Circulation, and four counts of Endangering the Welfare of a Child. This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney James Nguyen, of the Special Victims Unit.

36-year-old **Branden Spearman** was indicted on Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 2nd Degree. This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Emily Chisholm, of the Non-Fatal Shootings Bureau.

23-year-old **Raheem Gamble** and 23-year-old **Shaun Scott** were indicted on two counts of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 3rd Degree, Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 3rd Degree, Criminal Possession of a Firearm, and Tampering with Physical Evidence. This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Bridget Morgan, of the Special Investigations Bureau.

52-year-old **Shaun Hammond** was indicted on Strangulation in the 2nd Degree and Assault in the 2nd Degree. This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Courtney Kleiman, of the Special Victims Unit.

Upcoming Trials

The People vs. **Nathan Sinclair**

This defendant is charged with Assault in the 2nd Degree and Operator Leaving the Scene of Incident Resulting in Personal Injury, in front of Monroe County Court Judge Michael Ansaldi. This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Kristin Sippel, of the Major Felony Bureau.

The People vs. **Gregory Ulbright**

The defendant is charged with two counts of Driving While Intoxicated in front of Monroe County Court Judge Michael Ansaldi. This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Drew Kroft, of Vehicular Crimes Bureau.
