MCDAs in the Schools

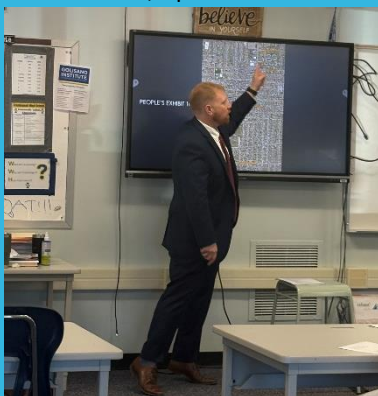

Notable Court Appearances

A Monroe County jury convicted 33-year-old **Kyshonn Green** of Murder in the 2nd Degree for the murder of J'Mere Ridley-Smith.

On July 26, 2025, at approximately 4:15PM, Gates Police Officers responded to the Wegmans distribution center on Brooks Avenue for reports of a shooting. Upon arrival, 25-year-old J'Mere Ridley-Smith was found deceased inside the distribution center with multiple gunshot wounds. He was working at the time of the homicide. After a thorough investigation, which included video evidence and eyewitness reports, Gates Police Detectives determined that Kyshonn Green, a different Wegmans employee, shot and killed J'Mere Ridley-Smith as the victim was working.

Following the homicides, Kyshonn Green fled New York State. He was apprehended in Knoxville, Tennessee by the U.S. Marshals Task Force and charged with the murder of J'Mere Ridley-Smith.

The case was prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney [Kevin Sunderland](#), Chief of the Local Courts Bureau, and Senior Assistant District Attorney [James Nguyen](#), of the Special Victims Unit. Kyshonn Green will be sentenced on June 30, 2026, in front of Monroe County Court Judge Douglas Randall.

19-year-old **Angel Cirilo** was indicted on Attempted Aggravated Murder of a Police Officer, Menacing a Police Officer or Peace Officer, and two counts of Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 2nd Degree. This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney [Emily Chisholm](#) of the Non-Fatal Shooting Taskforce.

50-year-old **Birkha Bahadur Bomjon** was indicted on Aggravated Driving While Intoxicated With a Child Passenger, Driving While Intoxicated, Driving While Intoxicated; BAC .08 or more, and Aggravated Driving While Intoxicated: Per se. This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District [Angela Carson](#), of the Vehicular Crimes Bureau.

17-year-old **Teshaun Newton** was indicted on Criminal Possession of Stolen Property in the 4th Degree, Unlawful Fleeing A Police Officer IN a Motor Vehicle in the 3rd Degree, and Resisting Arrest. This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney [Luke Schiano](#), of the Youth Part/Major Felony Bureau.

36-year-old **Brandon Baker** was indicted on Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 2nd Degree. This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney [Diana Ferretti](#), of the Special Investigations Bureau.

36-year-old **Devon Dates** was indicted on three counts of Aggravated Family Offense and Endangering the Welfare of a Child. This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney [Kenisha Flowers](#), of the Special Victims Unit.
