One of the greatest strengths of the Monroe County District Attorney's Office is the relationships we have built with our law enforcement partners. Every successful investigation, every thoughtful prosecution, and every safer neighborhood begins with collaboration. We share a common mission with the agencies we work alongside every day: protecting our community.

This week was another reminder that public safety is a true team effort. Members of our office assisted the Greece Police Department, alongside the New York State Office of Cannabis Management and other law enforcement partners, in a significant investigation that resulted in the seizure of approximately \$17 million in illegal cannabis products. Cases of this magnitude require hours of coordination, communication, and trust between agencies. We are proud to work alongside investigators whose dedication and professionalism make these outcomes possible.

Our partnerships extend well beyond the courtroom. This week, I also had the opportunity to attend Irondequoit National Night Out with Chief of the Victim/Witness Bureau Carrie Noble. Hosted by the Irondequoit Police Department, the event brought together law enforcement, community organizations, and families for an evening focused on building relationships and strengthening trust. These events remind us that crime prevention does not begin when a case reaches a prosecutor's desk, it begins with open conversations, community engagement, and visible partnerships between those who serve and those we serve.

Whether we are working alongside investigators on a complex criminal investigation, supporting victims through the prosecution process, or meeting residents at a neighborhood event, the goal remains the same: making Monroe County a safer place for everyone.



In the Courtroom

19-year-old **Nasir Jones** was indicted on Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 2nd Degree and Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 3rd Degree. This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Terance Calcagno, of the Special Investigations Bureau.

63-year-old **Isaac Lawhorn** was indicted on Assault in the 2nd Degree. This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Ryan Lamon, of the Major Felony Bureau.

47-year-old **Brenton Cummings** was indicted on Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 2nd Degree. This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Terance Calcagno, of the Special Investigations Bureau.

35-year-old **Shannen Morrison** was indicted on Burglary in the 2nd Degree, two counts of Criminal Mischief in the 4th Degree, and three counts of Endangering the Welfare of a Child. This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Kenisha Flowers, of the Special Victims Unit.

52-year-old **Eric Alexander** was indicted on Rape in the 1st Degree, Sexual Abuse in the 3rd Degree, Criminal Obstruction of Breathing or Blood Circulation, Harassment in the 2nd Degree, three counts of Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 2nd Degree, eight counts of Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 3rd Degree, and two counts of Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 4th Degree. This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Kristina Hinkley, of the Special Victims Unit.

23-year-old **Jaydialise Rodriguez** and 30-year-old **Jonathan Carrasquillo-Rosario** were indicted on Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 1st Degree, two counts of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 3rd Degree, Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 2nd Degree, two counts of Criminally Using drug Paraphernalia in the 2nd Degree, and Criminal Possession of a Rapid-Fire Modification Device. This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Jennifer Kennedy, Chief of the Special Investigations Bureau.

44-year-old **Stephen Sciarabba** was indicted on five counts of Criminal Contempt in the 1st Degree, two counts of Criminal Obstruction of Breathing or Blood Circulation, and Criminal Contempt in the 2nd Degree. This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Rachael Landauer, of the Special Victims Unit.

49-year-old **Omar Campos Osorio** was indicted on Burglary in the 3rd Degree. This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Joseph Flores, of the Local Courts Bureau.

Upcoming Trials

The People vs. **Tarrell Carter**

This defendant is charged with Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 1st Degree, six counts of Criminally Using Drug Paraphernalia in the 2nd Degree, two counts of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 2nd Degree, in front of New York State Supreme Court Justice Alex Renzi. This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Aaron Rath, of the Special Investigations Bureau.

The People vs. **Anthony Lopez**

The defendant is charged with Strangulation in the 2nd Degree, Assault in the 3rd Degree, and four counts of Criminal Contempt in the 2nd Degree in front of Monroe County Court Judge Douglas Randall. This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Armando Benitez, of the Special Victims Unit.

The People vs. **John Fulkerson**

The defendant is charged with Rape in the 1st Degree and Sexual Abuse in the 1st Degree in front of New York State Supreme Court Justice Thomas Moran. This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney David Dys, of the Special Victims Unit.

The People vs. **Caesarae Williams**

The defendant is charged with Assault in the 2nd Degree in front of New York State Supreme Court Justice Miller. This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Courtney Kleiman, of the Special Victims Unit.
