Dyquann Tucker Sentenced to 18 Year to Life

Rochester, NY- Today, Monroe County Court Judge John DeMarco sentenced 24 year old Dyquann Tucker to 18 years to life for the August 22, 2012 murder of 15 year old Max King. On that date, Dyquann Tucker fired two shots from a 9mm handgun at a small group of people in retaliation for a robbery/shooting of a friend that occurred a few days earlier on Roth Street. The victim, Max King, was not involved in the prior incident on Roth Street. Dyquann Tucker pled guilty to Murder 2nd on April 2, 2015.

The case was prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney and Deputy Bureau Chief of the Major Felony Bureau, Patrick Farrell.

"15 year old Max King was simply an innocent bystander. Dyquann Tucker clearly had no regard for Max King or this community the night he fired shots into a crowd of young people." said Patrick Farrell. "The only comfort we could offer the King family was to ensure that Mr. Tucker spent a significant amount of time in prison. Today's sentence proves that justice was served."

Dyquann Tucker will begin serving his sentence immediately.
