Upcoming Felony Trials

The trial for the **People vs. Henry Phelps, III and Marique Simkin** will continue into next week. This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Megan Hausner, of the Major Felony Bureau and Assistant District Attorney Matthew Hogestyn, also of the Major Felony Bureau.

Henry Phelps, III is charged with Murder in the 2nd Degree, five counts of Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 2nd Degree, and Assault in the 2nd Degree. Marique Simkin is charged with Murder in the 2nd Degree and two counts of Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 2nd Degree. This case is in front of New York State Supreme Court Justice Schiano.

The trial for the **People vs. Christopher Clookey** will continue into next week. This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Hillary Langdon, of the Special Victims Bureau.

The defendant is charged with Predatory Sexual Assault Against a Child in front of Monroe County Court Judge Miller.

November 27- People vs. Timothy Williams

This case is being prosecuted by Monroe County District Attorney Sandra Doorley and Assistant District Attorney Lisa Gray, Chief of the Appeals Bureau.

The defendant is charged with three counts of Murder in the 2nd Degree in front of New York State Supreme Court Justice Moran.

November 27- People vs. Alonzo Jones

This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Matthew Schwartz, Chief of the Major Felony Bureau.

The defendant is charged with Attempted Aggravated Murder, Attempted Aggravated Assault upon a Police Officer or Peace Officer, and two counts of Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 2nd Degree in front of Monroe County Court Judge Vacca.

November 27- People vs. Alphonse Barnwell

This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Aaron Rath, of the Domestic Violence Bureau.

The defendant is charged with two counts of Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 2^{nd} Degree, two counts of Criminal Contempt in the 1^{st} Degree, two counts of Criminal Obstruction of Breathing, and Menacing in the 2^{nd} Degree in front of Monroe County Court Judge Miller.

The defendant is charged with Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 2nd Degree, Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 3rd Degree, and Menacing in the Second Degree in front of Monroe County Court Judge Dollinger.

December 6- People vs. Shadad Alghaithy

This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Kevin Sunderland, of the Special Victims Bureau.

The defendant is charged with three counts of Rape in the 1st Degree, two counts of Rape in the 2nd Degree, three counts of Rape in the 3rd Degree, Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 2nd Degree, Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 3rd Degree, two counts of Sexual Abuse in the 1st Degree, Criminal Sexual Act in the 1st Degree, Criminal Sexual Act in the 3rd Degree, and Attempted Sexual Abuse in the 1st Degree in front of New York State Supreme Court Justice Schiano.

December 8- People vs. Princeston Williams

This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Aaron Rath, of the Domestic Violence Bureau.

The defendant is charged with Criminal Contempt in the 1^{st} Degree and two counts of Criminal Contempt in the 2^{nd} Degree in front of Monroe County Court Judge Miller.

The defendant is charged with Murder in the 1st Degree, Murder in the 2nd Degree, two counts of Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 2nd Degree, Criminal Possession of Stolen Property in the 4th Degree, Unauthorized Use of a Vehicle in the 3rd Degree, Unlawful Fleeing of a Police Officer in a Motor Vehicle in the 3rd Degree, and Reckless Driving in front of Monroe County Court Judge Vacca.

December 11- People vs. Master Bevel

The defendant is charged with Manslaughter in the 2nd Degree and Operator Leave Scene of Incident Resulting in Death in front of New York State Supreme Court Justice Argento.

MCDA in the Community

This past Monday, a press conference was held to spread awareness about proposed Senate bill S.2423, also referred to as the Elder Parole bill. Monroe County District Attorney Sandra Doorley was joined by New York State Senators, Pamela Helming and Robert Ortt, Ontario County District Attorney James Ritts, Monroe County Sheriff Todd Baxter, local police chiefs and law enforcement officers, as well as victims' families to discuss this dangerous Bill. The families in attendance included Lynn Mazurkiewicz, wife of Rochester Police Officer Anthony Mazurkiewicz, Nikki Siplin, mother of Richard Collinge, III and Judy Tosh, mother of Kali Ann Poulton, all of whom have incredible concern about the justice they received for their loved one being cut short due to this proposed bill. Senate bill S.2423 would make it so that any person incarcerated in the New York State Department of Corrections aged 55 or older, having served at least 15 years of their sentence, shall have a subsequent interview with the Board of Parole to determine whether they should be released to community supervision. Currently there are no carve outs based on the conviction. As written, every type of conviction is impacted, including murder, rape, and child abuse.
