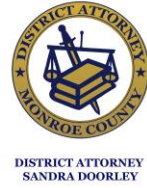

Welcome to the weekly newsletter from Monroe County District Attorney Sandra Doorley.

People vs. Raheim Robinson

Yesterday, Raheim Robinson was sentenced for the murders of Richard Collinge and MyJel Rand, in addition to over a dozen felony counts. This sentence brings the final resolution for the murders of Officer Mazurkiewicz, Richard Collinge, MyJel Rand, and the attempted murder of Officer Sino Seng.

Raheim Robinson was sentenced by Monroe County Court Judge Julie Hahn to multiple Life in the New York State Department of Corrections Without the Possibility of Parole sentences, in addition to multiple prison sentences for the other felony convictions. He was previously convicted by a jury of all counts including, four counts of Murder in the 1st Degree, twelve counts of Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 2nd Degree, Attempted Murder in the 2nd Degree, Reckless Endangerment in the 1st Degree, and Arson in the 4th Degree.

Before the trial, Deadrick Fulwiley pled guilty to two counts of Murder in the 2nd Degree and Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 2nd Degree for the murders of Richard Collinge and MyJel Rand. He was sentenced to 30 years to Life in the New York State Department of Corrections.

In February, Kelvin Vickers was also sentenced to multiple Life Without the Possibility of Parole sentences for the Aggravated Murder of Rochester Police Officer Anthony Mazurkiewicz, the murders of Richard Collinge and MyJel Rand, the attempted murder of Rochester Police Officer Sino Seng and dozens of other violent felony convictions.

Raheim Robinson, Deadrick Fulwiley, and Kelvin Vickers terrorized the community, spreading violence and mayhem in their wake from the night of July 19 to July 21 2022. Involved in days of nonstop bloodshed, these defendants devastated the community with gun violence, arson, and murder.

Thank you to the Rochester Police Department for putting as much work into finding justice for Richard Collinge and MyJel Rand, as you did for your fallen brother. As a danger to us all, Raheim Robinson, Deadrick Fulwiley, and Kelvin Vickers deserve to spend the remainder of their days in custody,

A few weeks ago, I discussed my admiration for Lynn Mazurkiewicz. She is an amazing woman and one of the strongest people I know.

But today, I want to talk about another impressive woman, Nikki Siplin, the mother of Richard Collinge. Yesterday, Nikki addressed the court at the sentencing of Raheim Robinson. Mr. Robinson could have taken responsibility for his actions, instead, he dragged a grieving mother through a second jury trial where she relived her son's final moments.

Nikki has been a rock, attending both trials hoping to seek justice for her son. I am relieved that she can finally rest knowing that her son's killers are all serving life sentences in the New York State Department of Corrections.

To Nikki, Lynn, the family of MyJel Rand, Officer Seng, the entire Rochester Police Department, and to the community, justice has been served.

Upcoming Felony Trials

Listed below are the felony trials scheduled over the next four weeks. I will keep you updated in the newsletter on the result of these trials.

June 24 - People vs. Jamar Graham

This case is being prosecuted Assistant District Attorney Hillary Langdon, of the Special Victims Unit.

The defendant is charged with fourteen counts of Predatory Sexual Assault, Kidnapping in the 1st Degree, and Criminal Obstruction of Breathing or Blood Circulation in front of Monroe County Court Judge Vacca.

June 24 - People vs. Jada McInnis

This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Aliyah Fowler, of the Major Felony Bureau.

The defendant is charged with Attempted Murder in the 2nd Degree, Assault in the 1st Degree, and Menacing in the 2nd Degree in front of Monroe County Court Judge Dollinger.

June 25 - People vs. Andrew Murray

This case is being prosecuted Assistant District Attorney Aaron Rath, of the Special Victims Unit.

The defendant is charged with Burglary in the 1st Degree and Criminal Mischief in the 4th Degree in front of New York State Supreme Court Justice Schiano.

June 24 - People vs. Tajeron Williams

This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Emily Chisholm, of the Major Felony Bureau.

The defendant is charged with two counts of Assault in the 2nd Degree in front of Monroe County Court Judge Hahn.

June 24 - People vs. Lorenzo Robinson

This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney James Nguyen, of the Special Victims Unit.

The defendant is charged with Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 2nd Degree in front of New York State Supreme Court Justice Argento.

June 25 - People vs. Jerome Douglas III

This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Stephen Ryck, of the Special Investigations Bureau.

The defendant is charged with five counts of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 3rd Degree and Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 4th Degree, in front of New York State Supreme Court Justice Moran.

July 8- People vs. Brandon Hall

This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Gregory Clark, Chief of the Public Integrity/Economic Crimes Bureau.

The defendant is charged with Murder in the 2nd Degree, two counts of Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 2nd Degree, and Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 3rd Degree in front of New York State Supreme Court Justice Argento.

July 8- People vs. Brandon Spears

This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Ryan Lamon, of the Youth Part/Major Felony Bureau.

The defendant is charged with Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 2nd Degree and Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 3rd Degree in front of New York State Supreme Court Justice Sinclair.

Norman Bounds, Jr. was indicted on Criminal Mischief in the 3rd Degree, Assault in the 3rd Degree, Criminal Obstruction of Breathing or Blood Circulation, and two counts of Endangering the Welfare of a Child in relation to a domestic related assault on November 25, 2023. This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Kenisha Flowers, of the Special Victims Unit.

Juan Ruiz was indicted on two counts of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 3rd Degree in relation to the possession of illegal narcotics on February 10, 2024. This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Robin Catalano, Chief of the Special Investigations Bureau.

Taquisha Taylor was indicted on Driving While Intoxicated and Aggravated Driving While Intoxicated With a Child Passenger in relation to a vehicular incident on February 3, 2024. This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Jonathan Jirik, of the Vehicular Crimes Bureau.

Leon Matthews III was indicted on Driving While Intoxicated and Aggravated Driving While Intoxicated: Per Se in relation to a vehicular incident on August 9, 2023. This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Diane Orosz-Roy, of the Vehicular Crimes Bureau.

Jordan Vanhouter was indicted on two counts of Burglary in the 3rd Degree in relation to burglaries on May 19, 2024, and May 22, 2024. This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Caroline Rodriguez, of the General Felony Bureau.

Terrance Harrell was indicted on Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 2nd Degree and Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 3rd Degree in relation to the possession of an illegal firearm on May 21, 2024. This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Tony DiPerna, of the Special Investigations Bureau.

Roger Greenlee was indicted on Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 3rd Degree, Criminal Possession of Stolen Property in the 3rd Degree, Criminal Possession of Stolen Property in the 4th Degree, Unauthorized Use of a Vehicle in the 3rd Degree, and Driving While Intoxicated in relation to the possession of an illegal firearm and a stolen motor vehicle on May 22, 2024. This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Diana Ferretti, of the Vehicular Crimes Bureau.

Devonta Hayes was indicted on Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 3rd Degree, Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 4th Degree, and Criminally Using Drug Paraphernalia in the 2nd Degree in relation to the illegal possession of narcotics on April 17, 2024.
