Robert Brewer Convicted of Murder in the Second Degree

Rochester, NY- Today, a Monroe County Jury found 25 year old Robert Brewer guilty of Murder in the Second Degree in the 2007 shooting death of Keith Holloway. On January 14th, 2007 William Miller of Elmira, solicited the help of Robert Brewer and co-defendant Justin Woodard to kill his twin sister's ex-boyfriend, Keith Holloway. On that day, the three men drove to Miller's sister's home at 831 Norton Street in Rochester, where they ambushed Holloway and executed him. All three defendants have now been convicted in Keith Holloway's murder. Robert Brewer was first convicted in 2007, but an Appellate Court sent the matter back for retrial. Brewer was convicted again today.

The case was prosecuted by Senior Assistant District Attorney Michael Bezer of the Major Felony Bureau.

"Robert Brewer has now been convicted by two separate juries for the murder of Keith Holloway. We can be assured he will spend most of the rest of his life behind bars for this calculated execution-style murder.", said Senior Assistant District Attorney Michael Bezer. "We appreciate the hard work of the Rochester Police Department as well as the jurors who considered this case. The victim's family deserves the justice they received today."

Robert Brewer is scheduled to be sentenced by Judge Francis Affronti on September 22, 2015. Brewer faces a sentence of 25 years to life.
