Judge Moran: Luis Pabon Guilty of Course of Sexual Conduct Against a Child

Rochester, NY- Today, Supreme Court Justice Thomas Moran found 39 year old Luis Pabon guilty of Course of Sexual Conduct Against a Child in the 1st degree (class B Felony) for sexually abusing a seven year old girl multiple times over a period of several months in the City of Rochester. The sexual abuse occurred in 1998, but the victim did not come forward until 2012.

The case was prosecuted for the People by Meredith Vacca of the Monroe County District Attorney's Office Special Victims Trial Division, following an investigation by the Rochester Police Department.

"I am especially proud of the victim in this case who, after holding in this secret for so long, finally found the courage to disclose the sexual abuse that she suffered years ago," said Vacca. "Now the man that did these horrible things to her has finally been brought to justice."

Pabon will be sentenced on February 11th before Judge Thomas Moran, where he faces up to 25 years in prison. Under New York State Law, the conviction will require Pabon to register as a sex offender. He was remanded to custody following the verdict, and will remain in the Monroe County Jail until the sentencing.
