Michael Albert a.k.a. "Gotti" Convicted of Second Degree Murder

Rochester, NY- Today, a Monroe County Jury found 29 year old Michael Albert guilty of Murder in the Second Degree for the April 29, 2006 murder of 20 year old Jeremy Trim. On that date, Albert shot and killed Trim on Lexington Avenue in the City of Rochester.

The case was prosecuted for the People by Patrick Farrell of the Monroe County District Attorney's Office Major Felonies Bureau, following an investigation by the Rochester Police Department. Critical evidence presented at trial included a recording of incriminating statements that Albert made to a confidential informant.

"After eight years, it was good to finally bring justice for Jeremy Trim and his family" said Farrell. "Michael Albert chose to carry an illegal gun and use it during a dispute. Now he has to answer for his actions."

Albert will be sentenced on July 11, 2014 before Monroe County Court Judge Vincent Dinolfo, where he faces up to 25 years to life in prison. Albert will remain in the Monroe County Jail pending sentencing.
