Law Enforcement Tragedy in our Community

I am devastated, I am outraged. Almost eight years ago, we lost a Rochester Police Officer in the line of duty. After Officer Pierson's death, we said, never again. We came together as a community. We rallied and supported our police officers. Now, the violence in our city and hatred for police has claimed another one of the brave officers doing his best to protect our community. While there are no words to make this better, on behalf of the Monroe County District Attorney's Office, we mourn for Officer Anthony Mazurkiewicz and we pray for his family and the City of Rochester. We support the Rochester Police Department and our dedicated law enforcement officers who continue to risk their lives, knowing that their brother died in the line of duty. We pray for a speedy recovery for Officer Seng. I will do my part to seek justice and accountability.

Monday we will both mourn the loss and celebrate the life of Officer Mazurkiewicz. Our community is forever indebted to his commitment and years of service keeping us safe. God Bless all of our Law Enforcement Officers, may they be safe as they continue to protect the community.

Highlights from the MCDA's Office

Dimitri Cash was sentenced to 115 years-to-life in the New York State Department of Corrections after previously being convicted of two counts of Kidnapping in the First Degree, two counts of Burglary in the First Degree, Robbery in the Second Degree and two counts of Conspiracy in the Fourth Degree, stemming from a home invasion and kidnapping that occurred on January 18, 2021. He was also convicted of Reckless Endangerment in the Second Degree, two counts of Custodial Interference in the Second Degree, and two counts of Endangering the Welfare of a Child for an incident that occurred at Autumn Lane Elementary School in January 2020. This case was prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Sara VanStrydonck, Chief of the Special Victims Bureau and Assistant District Attorney Patrick Gallagher, Chief of the Domestic Violence Bureau.

Joenathan Cash was sentenced to 75 years-to-life in the New York State Department of Corrections after previously being convicted of two counts of Kidnapping in the Second Degree, two counts of Burglary in the First Degree, Robbery in the Second Degree, two counts of Conspiracy in the Fourth Degree, and three counts of Unlawful Imprisonment in the First Degree stemming from a home invasion and kidnapping that occurred on January 18, 2021. This case was prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Sara VanStrydonck, Chief of the Special Victims Bureau and Assistant District Attorney Patrick Gallagher, Chief of the Domestic Violence Bureau.

Carl Lore was indicted on Kidnapping in the Second Degree, Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the Second Degree, Strangulation in the Second Degree, Unlawful Imprisonment in the First Degree, Assault in the Third Degree, Menacing in the Second Degree, and two counts Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the Third Degree in relation to an incident in the Town of Pittsford on July 2, 2022. This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Jessica Wagner of the Domestic Violence Bureau.

Treyshon Pittman was indicted on Murder in the Second Degree, three counts of Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the Second Degree, and Reckless Endangerment in the First Degree in relation to an incident in the City of Rochester on July 3, 2022. This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Bianca D'Angelo and Assistant District Attorney Aliyah Fowler of the Major Felony Bureau.

Maurice Bishop was indicted on Criminal Sexual Act in the First Degree, Strangulation in the Second Degree, Assault in the Second Degree, and Unlawful Imprisonment in the Second Degree in relation to an incident in the City of Rochester on June 28, 2022. This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Hillary Langdon of the Special Victims Bureau.

Dvonte Kennedy was indicted on Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the Second Degree, Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the Third Degree, and Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree in relation to an incident in the City of Rochester on July 9, 2022. This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Bridget Morgan of the Special Investigations Bureau.

Renaldo Napier was indicted on Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the Second Degree, Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the Third Degree, and Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree in relation to an incident in the City of Rochester on July 9, 2022. This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Bridget Morgan of the Special Investigations Bureau.

Remy Allen was indicted on Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the Second Degree in relation to an incident in the City of Rochester on April 1, 2022. This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Brandon Gonzalez of the Special Investigations Bureau.

Mizael Rosario was indicted on two counts Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the Second Degree in relation to an incident in the City of Rochester on March 24, 2022. This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Robin Catalano of the Special Investigations Bureau.

Carey Bradley was indicted on Assault in Second Degree and two counts Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the Second Degree in relation to an incident in the Town of Gates on July 3, 2022. This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Kristina Hinkley of the Domestic Violence Bureau.

Cashae Griffin was indicted on Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the Second Degree in relation to an incident in the City of Rochester on March 5, 2022. This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Brandon Gonzalez of the Special Investigations Bureau.

Terry Howard was indicted on Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the Second Degree in relation to an incident in the City of Rochester on March 5, 2022. This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Brandon Gonzalez of the Special Investigations Bureau.

Kron Hathaway was indicted on Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the Second Degree and Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the Third Degree in relation to an incident in the City of Rochester on March 24, 2022. This case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Matthew Hogestyn of the Special Investigations Bureau.

Nathan Stevenson was convicted of Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the Second Degree, two counts of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree, and Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Fourth Degree in relation to an incident in the City of Rochester that occurred August 27, 2019 in the City of Rochester. This case was prosecuted by Jennifer Kennedy of the Special Investigations Bureau.

James Hunter was sentenced to 65 years-to-life in the New York State Department of Corrections. This sentence comes after his jury conviction of Attempted Aggravated Murder of a Police Officer, Burglary in the First Degree, two counts of Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the Second Degree and Criminal Possession of Stolen Property in the Fifth Degree for the attempted murder and shooting of Bryan Sheridan, a 15 year veteran of the Rochester Police Department. This case was prosecuted by First Assistant District Attorney Perry Duckles and Assistant District Attorney Rachel Clark, Deputy Bureau Chief of the Domestic Violence Bureau.
