Akeem Harris Convicted of Murder in the Second Degree

Rochester, NY- Tuesday, May 30, 2017 a Monroe County Jury convicted 27 year old Akeem Harris of Murder in the 2nd degree, Attempted Murder in the 2nd degree, and two counts of Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 2nd degree. On November 7th, 2016 Harris brought a firearm and confronted Derick Reed at the corner of Frost Avenue and Jefferson Avenue in the City of Rochester. He ultimately gave the gun to his brother, Kadeem Harris, who then shot it seven times resulting in injury to Derick Reed and the death of Darryle Conner.

The case was prosecuted by Senior Assistant District Attorney Christine K. Callanan of the Major Felony Bureau.

"Darryle Conner was an innocent bystander that day. This case is a reminder of the danger guns pose to our community and to everyone's life" said Assistant District Attorney Christine K. Callanan. "We credit this verdict to the outstanding police work done by the Rochester Police Department". Harris will be sentenced July 14th before Judge Douglas A. Randall.
