Dimitri and Joenathan Cash Convicted by a Jury of All Charges

Rochester, NY- On Monday, May 23, 2022, a Monroe County Jury convicted 30-year-old Dimitri Cash and 23-year-old Joenathan of all charges.

Dimitri Cash was convicted of two counts of Kidnapping in the First Degree, two counts of Burglary in the First Degree, Robbery in the Second Degree and two counts of Conspiracy in the Fourth Degree, stemming from a home invasion and kidnapping that occurred on January 18 2021. He was also convicted of Reckless Endangerment in the Second Degree, two counts of Custodial Interference in the Second Degree, and two counts of Endangering the Welfare of a Child for an incident that occurred at Autumn Lane Elementary School in January 2020.

Joenathan Cash was convicted of two counts of Kidnapping in the Second Degree, two counts of Burglary in the First Degree, Robbery in the Second Degree, two counts of Conspiracy in the Fourth Degree, and three counts of Unlawful Imprisonment in the First Degree stemming from a home invasion and kidnapping that occurred on January 18 2021.

This case was prosecuted by Special Victims Bureau Chief, Sara VanStrydonck and Domestic Violence Bureau Chief, Patrick Gallagher.

"Dimitri and Joenathan Cash plotted for weeks to commit these heinous crimes, terrorizing an innocent family and ripping two children from the security of their own beds," said Assistant District Attorney Sara VanStrydonck. "These quick verdicts were only possible because of the extensive and collaborative investigation of the Greece Police Department and their partnership with the New York State Police, United States Marshalls and the Federal Bureau of Investigation."

"The acts that Dimitri and Joenathan Cash committed not only affected his intended victim's lives but also the foster family and community who searched to bring the children home safely," said Monroe County District Attorney Sandra Doorley. "I am pleased we were able to hold them accountable and secure justice for the unspeakable things they plotted and carried out."

Dimitri and Joenathan Cash will be sentenced on July 28, 2022, in front of State Supreme Court Justice Argento.
