“East Ave Rapist” Indicted

Rochester, NY- On Friday, a Monroe County Grand Jury indicted Marvin Sevilla-Rosales, 19, on over a dozen charges including two counts of Rape in the First Degree and Conspiracy in the Second Degree for the rape of two women in separate incidents in June and July of this year, and then subsequently attempting to have one of his alleged victims killed. Dubbed by many as the “East Ave Rapist,” Sevilla-Rosales is accused of raping one woman as she walked home from a restaurant in the area of East and Alexander on June 30th, and then another during the course of a burglary five days later. Sevilla-Rosales was later apprehended by police when a witness identified him from photographs. Once in custody, Sevilla-Rosales compounded the already serious charges that he faced by allegedly plotting to have one of his victims killed to ensure her silence. In sum, Marvin Sevilla-Rosales faces:

- 5 Counts Predatory Sexual Assault
- 2 Counts Rape in the 1st Degree
- 3 Counts Criminal Sexual Act in the 1st Degree
- 1 Count Sexual Abuse in the 1st Degree
- 1 Count of Conspiracy in the 2nd Degree

Marvin Sevilla-Rosales will be prosecuted for the People by Bureau Chief Julie Hahn of the Monroe County District Attorney's Office.

Sevilla-Rosales is being held without bail in Monroe County Jail awaiting arraignment, which is scheduled to occur on Friday.
