Tyquan Rivera and Co-Defendants Indicted on Drug Related Charges

Rochester, NY- Tuesday, January 7, 2020, a Monroe County Grand Jury indicted 25-year-old Tyquan Rivera and charged him with six counts of Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the 3rd Degree, five counts of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 3rd Degree and one count of Conspiracy in the 4th Degree for allegedly selling fentanyl on multiple occasions.

The same indictment charges Mr. Rivera's co-defendants. Specifically, Tevin Lise (29) is charged, along with Mr. Rivera, with Conspiracy in the Fourth Degree. Mr. Lise is also charged, along with Darrell Thomas (19) and Willie Kendrick (26), with Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 3rd Degree, Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 4th Degree and Criminally Using Drug Paraphernalia in the 2nd Degree. A fifth defendant, Michael Webb (30) was indicted for Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 3rd Degree, Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 4th Degree, three counts of Criminally Using Drug Paraphernalia in the 2nd Degree and Endangering the Welfare of a Child.

The indictment alleged events which occurred between September 2019 and December 2019.

The case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Matthew Schwartz, Chief of the Special Investigations Bureau and Assistant District Attorney Robin Catalano, Deputy Chief of the Special Investigations Bureau.
