## Jessier Robles Arraigned on Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 1<sup>st</sup> Degree

Rochester, NY- On Thursday, June 21, 20-year-old Jessier Robles was arraigned on Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 1<sup>st</sup> Degree, an A-I felony, 9 counts of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree, Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 5<sup>th</sup> Degree, Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree and Criminal Possession of a Firearm for incidents that occurred on April 5, 2018 and June 1, 2018.

On June 1, 2018 the Monroe County Heroin Task Force executed a search warrant of Robles residence. They discovered over 20 ounces of heroin along with large amounts of fentanyl and cocaine. Also found was a loaded handgun and drug paraphernalia commonly used to sell heroin, fentanyl and cocaine. Supreme Court Justice Thomas E. Moran set bail at \$100,000 cash or bond.

"The Monroe County Heroin Task Force was developed as a collaborative effort of law enforcement and community partners to combat the horrific effects the heroin epidemic has on our community," said Monroe County District Attorney Sandra Doorley. "This is one of the largest returns on a search warrant executed by the Task Force. We hope to continue to have success like this in the future in an effort to remove these deadly drugs from our streets."

If convicted, Robles is facing a minimum of 8 years and a maximum of 29 years in the New York State Department of Corrections.

Jessier Robles next court date is August 6, 2018 for motion arguments.
