**Jarvis Lewis Sentenced to 40 Years for Four Counts of Criminal Possession of
a Weapon in the Second Degree, One Count of Assault in the Second Degree
and One Count of Resisting Arrest**

Rochester, NY- On July 13, 2022, New York State Supreme Court Justice Thomas Moran sentenced 32-year-old Jarvis Lewis to 40 years in the New York State Department of Corrections with five years post-release supervision.

This sentence comes after his jury conviction of four counts of Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the Second Degree, one count of Assault in the Second Degree and one count of Resisting Arrest. The defendant's conviction stemmed from the illegal possession of various weapons in May and June 2021 and his assault on a Rochester Police Officer.

The case was prosecuted by Special Assistant District Attorney Megan Hausner of the Major Felony Bureau.

"I am pleased with today's sentencing" said Assistant District Attorney Megan Hausner. "Jarvis Lewis is a violent predicate offender who has shown repeated disregard for the law, law enforcement officers and the safety of others."

"Possessing an illegal weapon is a serious offense, even more so as a violent predicate offender" said Monroe County District Attorney Sandra Doorley. "Jarvis Lewis' sentencing today was just and deserved. He now has a very long time in the Department of Corrections to think about the crimes he committed."
