Jordin Campbell Sentenced 6-18 Years for Aggravated Vehicular Homicide

Rochester, NY- July 31, 2019, 22-year-old Jordin Campbell was sentenced by State Supreme Court Justice Alex Renzi to 6-18 years in the New York State Department of Corrections after pleading guilty to the top count of the indictment, Aggravated Vehicular Homicide after causing the death of Anthony Mykins.

At approximately 11:10PM on January 3, 2019, after having voluntarily consumed alcohol to the state of intoxication, Jordin Campbell drove his car at speeds in excess of 80 mph in a 35 mph zone on Clay Rd in the Town of Henrietta. His actions caused two passengers to be ejected, causing the death of his friend Anthony Mykins and serious physical injury to two other passengers.

The case was prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Raymond Benitez, Bureau Chief of the DWI Bureau.

"On the night of January 3, Jordin Campbell was responsible for Anthony Mykins losing his life, while also destroying the lives of his other victims and their families," said Assistant District Attorney Benitez. "Mr. Campbell made a series of terrible decisions that led to these horrendous actions and will now have years in the New York State Department of Corrections filled with regret to think about that tragic night."

"The Monroe County District Attorney's Office and our law enforcement partners say it over and over again, making poor choices behind the wheel of a car can lead to tragedy," said District Attorney Sandra Doorley. "Driving under the Influence is a choice, not an accident. Jordin Campbell made that choice and is not only responsible for the life of Anthony Mykins and the injuries of his friends, but he will now spend the rest of his youth behind bars."
