Indictment Unsealed Charging Kelly Goff with Manslaughter in the 2nd Degree and Other Felony Charges

On October 12, 2021, an indictment was unsealed in front of New York State Supreme Court Justice Schiano charging 38-year-old Kelly Goff with Manslaughter in the 2nd Degree, Tampering with Physical Evidence in the 2nd Degree and two counts of Criminal Injection of a Narcotic Drug.

This case was investigated by the Monroe County Heroin Task Force and the Brighton Police Department. This indictment states that on September 2, 2020, in the Town of Brighton, Mr. Goff was responsible for the overdose death of Tushar Ram by injecting him with a narcotic drug. Kelly Goff was arraigned after the indictment was unsealed and bail was set at \$5,000 cash, \$10,000 bond, and \$40,000 partially secured bond.

This case is being prosecuted by Special Assistant District Attorney Jennifer Kennedy, of the Special Investigations Bureau and Assistant District Attorney Jenna Markwitz, also of the Special Investigations Bureau. The next scheduled court date is October 19, 2021, for motion arguments.
