**District Attorney Sandra Doorley Appoints Mark Monaghan as New Second Assistant with Retirement of Thirty-year Assistant District Attorney, Timothy Prosperi**

District Attorney Sandra Doorley is pleased to announce the appointment of Mark Monaghan as Second Assistant District Attorney. Assistant District Attorney Mark Monaghan will take over for Timothy Prosperi who is retiring after 30 years of dedicated service to the office and to our community.

Monaghan was hired by former District Attorney Howard Relin and sworn in as an Assistant District Attorney in July 2002. Under Mr. Relin and his successor, Mike Green, ADA Monaghan was assigned over the next nine years to positions within the Local Court Bureau, Domestic Violence Bureau, D.W.I. Bureau, and Superior Court Non-Violent Felony Bureau.

Upon being elected District Attorney in 2011, Ms. Doorley selected Monaghan to head her newly established Economic Crime Bureau. He has been the Bureau Chief there since.

Monaghan is a native of Monroe County. He was born in Rochester and raised in the Town of Greece. He is a graduate of Greece Athena High School and SUNY Geneseo. ADA Monaghan received his law degree from Indiana University-Bloomington before returning to practice in his home town.

Regarding the new assignment ADA Monaghan said, "During my 16 years in the District Attorney's Office, performance monitoring and identifying ways to make our prosecutors and support staff most effective have been important objectives. Those efforts are particularly gratifying to me because they yield benefits that affect everyone involved: prosecutors, support staff, victims, witnesses, and every other member of the community touched by a criminal case. Focusing my knowledge and experience on those objectives is an exciting proposition."
