## Juan Perez-Flores Arraigned for Death of 20-Year-Old Ashley Arroyo-Bautista

Rochester, NY- 32-year-old Juan Perez-Flores was arraigned in front of Monroe County Court Judge John DeMarco after a two count indictment was unsealed, charging him with one count of Murder in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree and one count of Burglary in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree. In July 2016, the Rochester Police Department was called to a home on Wilkins Street in the City of Rochester. At the house, officers found the deceased body of 20-year-old Ashley Arroyo-Bautista. At the time of the victim's death, Perez-Flores was on parole for an Attempted Robbery in the 1<sup>st</sup> Degree conviction from 2009. Perez-Flores has been in custody since Arroyo-Bautista's death on a violation of his parole. He is scheduled to appear in Monroe County Court on April 26, 2017.
