Grand Jury Files Indictment Charging Tremaine Coley With Murder in the 2nd Degree in Connection with Homicide

Rochester, NY- On Friday, October 5, 2018, after a thorough investigation by the Rochester Police Department in conjunction with the Monroe County District Attorney's Office, an indictment was filed charging 38-year-old Tremaine Coley with one count of Murder in the Second Degree for the intentional death of Tasmere Kenard on Lyell Avenue in the City of Rochester on September 14, 2018. He was also charged with two counts of Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the Second Degree and one count of Robbery in the First Degree. Co-defendant, 38 year old Delvern Duran, was charged with Robbery in the First Degree.

This case is being prosecuted by Senior Assistant District Attorneys Bianca D'Angelo and Michael Robertson.

Coley and Duran are scheduled to appear at a later date in Superior Court for arraignment.
