Nikey Hall Sentenced on Assault of his 1 Year Old Daughter

Rochester, NY- Today, Supreme Court Justice Alex R. Renzi sentenced 26 year old Nikey Hall to 25 years in State Prison, plus 5 years post release supervision. On January 5, 2015, Nikey Hall brutally assaulted his 1 year old daughter at his home in the City of Rochester. According to doctors, the child sustained blunt force trauma to the head, and as a result, she lives with permanent brain injuries that will prevent her from ever walking or talking.

The case was prosecuted by Senior Assistant District Attorney Meredith Vacca of the Child Abuse Bureau.

"On January 5, 2015, Nikey Hall demonstrated he is a violent individual who should not be around children. His daughter will never recover from the injuries but Nikey Hall will be held accountable for his actions", said Assistant District Attorney Meredith Vacca. "Today's sentencing should send a strong message of intolerance to those who abuse children in our community."

Nikey Hall will begin serving his sentence immediately.
