Vincenzo Scaccia Sentenced for Vehicular Assault in the Second Degree

Rochester, NY- Today, County Court Judge Victoria Argento sentenced 20 year old Vincenzo Scaccia to 6 months in the Monroe County Jail and 5 years Probation as an adult for his November 10, 2015 conviction of two counts of Vehicular Assault (Marihuana and combined influence of Marihuana and Clonazepam) in the Second Degree and two counts of DWAI (Marihuana and combined influence of Marihuana and Clonazepam). On April 26, 2014, Vincenzo Scaccia drove his SUV while impaired on Marihuana and Clonazepam and crashed into a stationary object, a large commercial dumpster filled with concrete which was sitting in a front yard of a residence on Holt Road in the Town of Webster. His 17 year old female passenger suffered a Traumatic Brain Injury.

The case was prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney David Siguenza of the DWI Bureau.

"Vincenzo Scaccia was sentenced today as an adult for his reckless behavior on April 26, 2014," said Assistant District Attorney David Siguenza. "On that day, Scaccia forever changed the life of his 17 year old female passenger when he chose to drive while under the influence of drugs. She will never be the same as she suffered a Traumatic Brain Injury. It is our hope that Vincenzo Scaccia will learn from this experience while serving time in jail."
