Dear Neighbor:

Monroe County plans to rehabilitate the existing bridge carrying **Turk Hill Road over Thomas Creek Tributary** in the Town of Perinton/Village of Fairport. This bridge is located approximately 140 feet north of Cobb's Lane.

The existing bridge was originally constructed in 1984. The bridge has been inspected regularly and has been deemed by the Monroe County Department of Transportation to be near the end of its useful life. The existing bridge is proposed to be rehabilitated by constructing a new corrugated structural plate liner inside of the existing corrugated metal pipe arch structure, which will preserve and prolong the service life of the bridge by an anticipated 50 additional years.

Construction is scheduled to begin in the spring of 2027. During that time, Turk Hill Road will remain open and traffic will be maintained across the bridge.

The project is estimated to take approximately 5 months to complete. Additional information will be sent out in the spring of 2027 in advance of the project.
