**RE: SOUTH WINTON ROAD REHABILITATION
JEFFERSON ROAD (NY-252) TO BRIGHTON-HENRIETTA
TOWNLIN ROAD
TOWN OF HENRIETTA, MONROE COUNTY**

Dear Neighbor,

Monroe County has completed Preliminary Design for the above referenced project. Based on the preliminary design studies, the existing lane configurations and pavement width will be maintained and the pavement surface, drainage system, and traffic signal system will all be rehabilitated or replaced.

Drainage structures will be repaired and raised to correct grade as needed. Drainage pipes under the pavement will be replaced or re-lined. The existing traffic signal at the intersection of South Winton Road / Brighton-Henrietta Townline Road will be replaced and upgraded with a mast-arm traffic signal (with pedestrian signals). The entire pavement surface will be milled and resurfaced. Concrete sidewalks will also be installed on both sides of the road.

The project design is progressing and construction is scheduled for 2021. (Note that a separate, un-related, project to replace the existing watermain on S. Winton Road will be completed during the 2020 construction season by the Monroe County Water Authority).
